## Opportunities and Donor Recognition Program

As part of the Library's *Lifelong Learning* campaign, the Board of Directors is committed to publicly recognizing *every* contributor of \$250 or more who helped to make the new library a reality.

### ***Naming Opportunities: \$10,000 or more***

Contributors who have committed at least \$10,000 over three years are encouraged to select a prominent area or location in the new library to recognize their participation or to honor a parent, child or children, or friend.

Certain locations lend themselves to the inclusion of a contributor's actual name - *The Mary Smith Periodical Reading Room*, for instance. Other areas such as the Main Lobby / Circulation Area, Computer Learning Area or Coffee and Lounge Area are more appropriate for the prominent placement of an attractive recognition plaque (situated nearby) that acknowledges the contributor's generosity but without "naming" the selected area.
