
HOW TO BEGIN KIDSPEOK

Children can join this program with KidSpeak, which provides a more animated and interactive experience.

Each language is hosted by a fun cartoon "friend" and his or her playful pet, guiding you through interactive activities, puzzles, and songs.



To access KidSpeak, make sure that to select a language that offers the KidSpeak program. Once you have selected a language, you can go on the top toolbar and hover over the **KidSpeak** dropdown. Click on **Open KidSpeak**.




The program will begin with an animated intro. When it pauses, it will allow you to select one of the buttons on the screen to begin an educational game.

The button for Transparent Language Online looks like this.




LOGIN YOUR ACCOUNT | YOUR LEARNING PATH

It will take you to Transparent Language Online's login page afterwards.




You can either follow the instructions for signing up for an account OR you can Continue as a Guest. If you log in as a guest, your progress will not be saved.


SELECT THE LANGUAGE YOU WANT TO LEARN

KidSpeak means that they have a version of language learning meant for children.




To access the program, you will start with My Learning Path. Your path can be customized to your desire. You do not have to start from the beginning.
